### Spring Feature - Gize's Journey: From Hardship to Hope

#### Empowering Women with Self-Help Groups at The Youth Impact Center

Gize, a single mother of two young children, found herself struggling to navigate life after her husband left her for another woman. Overwhelmed by despair and financial hardship, she often battled frustration, which sometimes affected her relationship with her children. In the midst of this turmoil, the opportunity arose for her to join Youth Impact's Family Strengthening Program.

The program provided her with mentorship, counseling, and capacity-building training, helping her find a safe space where she could connect with other women who shared similar challenges. Through these weekly meetings, Gize realized she was not alone—there were others who understood her pain and uplifted one another through shared experiences.

With time, she began to gain fresh perspectives. She started to believe that her future was still in her hands and that small, meaningful changes could shape a better life for herself and her children. The one-on-one counseling sessions and home visits deepened her self-awareness, and she embarked on a spiritual journey. Embracing Jesus as her Lord and Savior, Gize found peace that she had never known before. Her anger gradually melted away, replaced by renewed hope and a sense of purpose.

One of the most empowering aspects of the program was its savings and credit association, which enabled members to access financial support. Gize took her first loan to launch a small vegetable business, selling fresh produce in her neighborhood. As her confidence grew, she took out additional loans, expanding her business step by step. What had started as survival has transformed into prosperity.

Today, Gize thrives—not just as a businesswoman but as a role model in her community. She continues attending group meetings, encouraging others to embrace their potential. Actively involved in Bible study and church programs, she shares her testimony of resilience, faith, and determination.

Her journey stands as a powerful reminder that, with the right support, no struggle is insurmountable, and hope can light even the darkest paths.
